- Any special arrangements or props for your demo must be approved by Show Management prior to the show. Your organization must provide all props. Props must be set up and removed during the time allotted for your demonstration.
- All persons who handle, ride or otherwise work around horses at the expo are required to sign and return a release.

Other required forms: Stall Reservation, Release, current neg. coggins and, **if applicable**, Contract for Booth Space, health certificate, clinic application, as required for your category.
